

## 海洋公園 (本園) 榮譽大小熊貓護理員參加細則及申請須知

### 誰能參加榮譽大小熊貓護理員？

為保障參加者、本園職員以至動物的健康和 safety，本園因此制訂以下《參加者資格及條件》。每位參加者必須符合《參加者資格及條件》，方可參加本活動。在活動進行期間，如動物監督發現任何參加者並不符合《參加者資格及條件》中任何一項，該參加者將會被要求終止參與本活動，而參加者必須立刻遵照此等指示。

### 甲部：參加者資格及條件

1. 參加者必須年滿 8 歲或以上。
2. 未滿 15 歲之參加者必須由家長/監護人<sup>註1</sup>陪同參加此活動。該家長/監護人必須負責參加者之安全及行為。15 至 17 歲之參加者需得到其家長/監護人同意及於報名表上簽署，方可參加。
3. 參加者必須填妥及簽署有關個人健康申報，方可進行此活動。未滿 15 歲之參加者必須由陪同之家長/監護人填寫及加簽。
4. 參加者必須在參加活動前簽署一份豁免責任書，另未滿 18 歲之參加者必須由其家長/監護人加簽，方可參加本活動。
5. 活動主要以廣東話，輔以英語或普通話進行。若需普通話輔助解說，請於參加表格上註明。
6. 任何情況下，參加者均須絕對遵從動物監督之指示。
7. 任何參加者若感染預防及控制疾病條例(香港法例第 599 章)第一附表中載明之任何傳染病<sup>註2</sup>，均不能參與本活動。
8. 本園並不建議孕婦參與本活動。如有孕婦欲參與本活動，必須出示經由本港註冊醫生之證明文件，以證其孕婦本身及其胎兒均適合參與此活動方可參加。
9. 參加者如患有以下疾病，包括但不限於發燒、咳嗽、傷風/感冒、作嘔、腹瀉、嘔吐、皮膚病、心臟病、肺病、血友病、腦癱症、接觸動物時出現昏厥/眩暈/失去知覺徵狀、對動物有恐懼、或免疫缺損者，本園並不建議參與本活動。
10. 所有參加者於活動開始前必須由本園職員量度體溫，若體溫高於攝氏 38 度，本園職員有權拒絕參加者參加活動。
11. 本園並不建議指甲上貼有飾物之人士參加此活動。此類參加者必須於與海豚接觸前以醫生膠布包裹指甲確保安全。
12. 本園之動物監督擁有最終權力決定任何參加者是否適合參與活動。
13. 本園有權更改以上之參加者資格及條件，恕不另行通知。

註 2：該傳染病包括急性脊髓灰質炎(小兒麻痺)、阿米巴痢疾、炭疽、桿菌痢疾、水痘、基孔肯雅熱、霍亂、社區型耐甲氧西林金黃葡萄球菌感染、克雅二氏症、登革熱、白喉、腸病毒 71 型感染、大腸桿菌、食物中毒、甲型流行性感冒(H2)、甲型流行性感冒(H5)、甲型流行性感冒(H7)、甲型流行性感冒(H9)、豬型流行性感冒、日本腦炎、退伍軍人病、麻瘋、鉤端螺旋體病、李斯特菌病、瘧疾、麻疹、腦膜炎雙球菌感染(入侵性)、流行性腮腺炎、副傷寒、鼠疫、鸚鵡熱、寇熱、狂犬病、回歸熱、風疹(德國麻疹)及先天性風疹綜合症、猩紅熱、嚴重急性呼吸系統綜合症、天花、豬鏈球菌感染、破傷風、結核病、傷寒、斑疹傷寒及其他立克次體病、病毒性肝炎、西尼羅河病毒感染、百日咳和黃熱病。

### 乙部：報名須知

由於活動名額有限，如欲參加，請遞交報名表格預約，或致電 3923-2328 向教育部查詢。先到先得，額滿即止。

## 報名方法

- 參加者可透過以下方法報名：
  - 透過網上及傳真:最少於活動日前 1 天下午 3 時前；
  - 親臨海洋公園正門票務處: 最少於活動日前 1 天下午 3 時前；
  - 如當日活動尚未額滿，遊客可於正門票務處或指定之紀念品店即場報名。
    - 每張申請表格只限一位參加者填寫。如有需要，可自行影印。
    - 申請之活動日期必需為三個月內 (由申請日起計算)。
    - 本園將於收到網上或傳真申請表後以電郵通知參加者。參加費用將於收到網上或傳真申請表後一日內以信用卡繳交。
    - 如參加者未能於以上所述時間內繳交參加費用，其申請將會當作自動棄權論。本園有權把該參加者之活動日期撥予其他申請者
- 未滿 15 歲之參加者，其申請表必須由家長/監護人填寫及簽署。
- 除丙部所列明之條款以外，申請一經確定，參加者不得轉換活動日期。所繳交之費用不得轉讓他人或退款。
- 每節名額：4 位
- 參加者必須準時於指定地點集合，逾時不候。本園亦有權決定是否讓逾時者參加此活動。
- 工作人員將以參加者之姓名、確定通知書及訂購活動時所用的信用卡以作核對之用。
- 請於活動當日出示有效的智紛全年入場證正本以作核對(如適用)，否則本園有權取消活動優惠，參加者須於活動開始前繳交活動費用差額。
- 基於安全理由，參加者於活動期間不會與動物有直接接觸。
- 為保持幕後設施衛生，參加者必須於活動期間穿上本園提供之工作服。
- 請自備保暖衣物，以便穿著於工作服內。
- 請穿著防滑鞋參與此活動。
- 本活動不接受隨行訪客。
- 所有活動行程或內容如有更改，恕不另行通知。
- 參加本活動之人士，必須持有活動當日有效之海洋公園入場門票。本活動之費用並不包括入場門票。

## 丙部：活動取消

本活動有可能因以下情況而取消：

- 惡劣天氣包括但不限於香港天文台發出之 8 號或以上之颱風訊號或黑色暴雨警告，以至本活動不能進行；  
或
  - 參加者、本園職員或動物的安全理由；或
  - 本園之動物及教育部執行總監或其授權人擁有最終決定權即時終止或取消本活動。
- 因上述情況而受影響之參加者，本園會重新安排活動日期及時間。

活動部分收益將撥捐香港海洋公園保育基金，以支持基金推行保育大熊貓的研究及教育推廣工作。

## Ocean Park (the Park) Honorary Pandas Keeper Programme Rules and Regulations

### Who can join the programme?

For the health and safety of our participants, staffs and animals, the following criteria have been established by the Park. Every participant must meet these criteria. If at any time during the programme any participant is assessed by the animal Supervisor as not being able to fulfil any of the following criteria, he/she will be asked to leave the programme and he/she must immediately comply with such a direction.

### Section I: Criteria for participation

1. Participants must be aged 8 or above.
2. Participants under the age of 15 years must join this programme with a parent/guardian <sup>Remark 1</sup>. The participating parent/guardian shall have responsibility for the child's safety and behaviour at all times and is obliged to conduct himself or herself in such manner so as to achieve this. Participants at age between 15 and 17 shall obtain parental or guardian approval in advance (to be signed in the enrolment form).
3. Participants, or in the case of participants under the age of 15, their parent/guardian must complete and sign a Health Declaration Form before the programme starts.
4. Participants, or in the case of participants under the age of 18, their parent/guardian must sign a Liability Release Form before joining the programme.
5. The programme will mainly be conducted in Cantonese supplemented with English or Putonghua. Putonghua speaking session could be arranged upon request on application form.
6. Participants must at all times strictly follow each and every direction given by the animal supervisor and to the satisfaction of the supervisor giving the instruction.
7. Participants must not be suffering from any infectious disease <sup>Remark 2</sup> specified in the First Schedule to the Prevention and Control of Disease Ordinance (Cap 599 of the laws of Hong Kong).
8. This programme is not recommended to any pregnant person. Any person who is pregnant may only participate upon producing a valid current approval from a Hong Kong certified medical practitioner certifying that it is safe for the expectant mother and baby for her to participate.
9. Participants suffering from any disease (including, but not limited to fever, coughing, cold/flu, nausea, diarrhoea, vomiting, skin disease, heart disease, lung disease, haemophilia, epilepsy, fainting/giddiness/loss of consciousness when in close contact with animals, phobia of animals, or depressed immune mechanisms) are not recommended to participate in this programme.
10. All participants must pass a body temperature check by the Park's staff before the commencement of the programme. If a participant's body temperature is higher than 38°C, he or she may not be permitted to join the programme.
11. Participants with embossed accessories on their acrylic or gel nails are not recommended to join this programme. To comply with safety considerations, they must warp their nails with medical tape before the encounter.
12. The Terrestrial Mammal supervisor from the Park reserves the rights to determine whether the participants are eligible to join the programme or not.
13. The criteria listed above are subjected to change at the discretion of the Park and without prior notice.

Remark 1: 'Guardian' has the same meaning as in the < Guardianship of Minors Ordinance >.

Remark 2: These diseases include acute poliomyelitis, amoebic dysentery, anthrax, bacillary dysentery, botulism, chickenpox, chikungunya fever, cholera, community-associated methicillin-resistant staphylococcus aureus infection, creutzfeldt-jakob disease, dengue fever, diphtheria, enterovirus 71 infection, escherichia coli O157:H7 infection, food poisoning, haemophilus influenza type b infection (invasive), hantavirus infection, influenza A (H2), influenza A (H5), influenza A (H7), influenza A (H9), swine influenza, Japanese encephalitis, legionnaires' disease, leprosy, leptospirosis, listeriosis, malaria, measles, meningococcal infection (invasive), mumps, paratyphoid fever, plague, psittacosis, Q fever, rabies, relapsing fever, rubella and congenital rubella syndrome, scarlet fever, severe acute respiratory syndrome, smallpox, streptococcus suis infection, tetanus, tuberculosis, typhoid fever, typhus and other rickettsial diseases, viral haemorrhagic fever, viral hepatitis, west Nile virus infection, whooping cough, and yellow fever.

## Section II: Application Procedure

As the capacity of Honorary Pandas Keeper Programme is limited, to ensure a place it is recommended to make a reservation by submitting application form, or contacting Education Department at 3923-2328 prior to attending the Park. Application will be considered on a first-come-first served basis.

### Application Procedure

1. Reservations can be made by the following methods:
  - Via Internet or Fax: A minimum of 1 day advance booking before 3pm.
  - In-person at Ocean Park Ticketing Office at Main Entrance: A minimum of 1 day advance booking before 3pm.
  - On-site applications for the programme can be made at Main Entrance Ticketing Office or appointed souvenir shop, subject to availability at the time of application.
- 1.1 One application form is to be used for one applicant only. Please photocopy the form if necessary.
- 1.2 Date of programme must be booked within 3 months from the date of application.
- 1.3 Upon receiving the completed application form via internet or fax, the applicant will be received an email confirmation letter. Payment will be settled within 1 day by credit card.
- 1.4 If the payment is not received within the aforementioned period, the application will automatically be cancelled and the vacancy will be made available to other interested parties.
2. In the case of participants under the age of 15, the application form must be completed and signed by his/her parent/guardian.
3. Programme date cannot be changed after confirmation, except in the circumstances stated in Section III. All payments made are non-refundable and non-transferable.
4. Session capacity: 4
5. Please arrive the gathering point punctually. Late-comer might not be admitted to the programme.
6. Participant's name, confirmation letter and the credit card used for payment should be presented for verification on the date of visit.
7. Please present the original SmartFun Annual Pass for verification purpose on the programme date (if applicable). If fail to comply, participant must settled the price difference before the programme commencement.
8. Due to safety reasons, no direct contact with our animals will be offered during the programme.
9. For hygiene reasons in back-of-house facilities, participants will be requested to put on working suit provided by the Park.
10. Please bring warm clothes to be dressed under the working suit if necessary.
11. Please wear a pair of clean and skid-proof hiking shoes.
12. No accompanying guest is allowed.
13. The itinerary or content of the programme may be subject to change without prior notice.
14. A valid admission ticket to the Park is required for joining the programme. The price of the admission ticket is not included in the programme fee.

## Section III: Cancellation

**Cancellation of the Programme may be made under the following circumstances:**

1. Inclement weather, including but not limited to the hoisting of typhoon signal no.8 or above or black rainstorm warning issued by The Hong Kong Observatory; or,
2. Any safety issue of any participant, staff or animal; or,
3. Decision for immediate cancellation of the Programme at sole discretion of the Director of Zoological Operations & Education Division of Ocean Park or his/her delegate.

**Part of the programme proceeds will go to the Ocean Park Conservation Foundation, Hong Kong to support its research projects and public awareness programmes for wildlife conservation in Asia.**
